### **Eligibility:**

- Applicants must be a graduating Senior at a High School within the City of Claremont.
- Applicants must have a 3.0 or better GPA, and submit a current transcript with their application and essay.
- Applicants must be enrolled full-time in college, university or trade school in the fall of 2017.
- Applicants must submit an essay between 300-400 words on "what local organization would you join, and why do you feel it's important to the community."
- Applicants must submit or have postmarked their application no later than April 17, 2017.

Notification of scholarship awards will be made no later than May 26, 2017. Applicants must be available for the Award Ceremony at the Woman's Club on June 14, 2017, 11:30-1:00 pm, at 343 West 12<sup>th</sup> Street in Claremont.
