Eligibility:

- Applicants must be a graduating Senior at a High School within the City of Claremont.
- Applicants must have a 2.0 or better GPA, and submit a current transcript with their application and essay.
- Applicants must be enrolled full-time in a junior college, Cal State, trade/tech school or a 4-year university by Fall of 2018.
- Applicants must submit an essay between 200-300 words on : *"The Woman's Club of Claremont has celebrated 100 years in our Community. What ideas do you have to keep the Woman's Club of Claremont thriving for the next 100 years?"*
- Applicants must submit or have postmarked their application no later than May 11, 2018.

Notification of scholarship awards will be made no later than May 31, 2018.

Applicants must be available for the Award Ceremony at the Woman's Club on June 13, 2018, 11:30-1:00 pm, at 343 West 12th Street in Claremont.

There will be five \$1,000.00 scholarships awarded.

We will award one each to a High School Senior who will be enrolled in the Fall of 2018 : Junior College, Cal State, 4-year UC, Private 4-year, Trade/Tech school.

Family members of Executive Board Members and or WCC Scholarship Committee Members are ineligible.
